

Developmental Screening - Waterford School District Families

Introduction

Waterford School District families have access to free ASQ-3 questionnaires online. These questionnaires help families with awareness of their child's strengths and weaknesses within key developmental areas. Research indicates that early intervention increases the chance a child has to reach his/her potential so please do the questionnaire for your child today.

The **ASQ®-3** identifies developmental progress in children between the ages of one month to 5 ½ years.

- Parents are typically able to complete it in 10–15 minutes
- A quick way to check your child's development
- Areas screened: Communication, Gross Motor, Fine Motor, Problem Solving, Personal-social

The **ASQ:SE-2** focuses on social-emotional development.

- Parents are typically able to complete it in 10–15 minutes
- A quick way to check your child's development
- Areas screened: Autonomy, Compliance, Adaptive Functioning, Self-regulation, Affect, Interaction, Social-communication

STEP 1
