- Children must be three by December 1, 2008 or four by December 1, 2008.
- Transportation is available.

Free Programs Funded by the State of Michigan

Available for Waterford School District children who will be four by December 1, 2008 and meet two of the following criteria:

- Single parent household
- Language deficiency or immaturity
- Family history of low school achievement or dropout
- Lack of stable support system of residence
- Family history of diagnosed family problems
- Low family income
- Substance abuse or addiction
- Diagnosed handicapping conditions
- Other conditions (Health and/or Educational Concerns, Family Issues) which could affect learning
