## ***The Waterford Foundation Al Dittrich Scholarship***

Al Dittrich was a man dedicated to community service. He was known for his caring and generosity to deserving individuals and organizations. By virtue of his giving spirit he touched many lives. In his memory, The Al Dittrich Foundation and Waterford Foundation for Public Education has set up two \$2,500 scholarships (adjusted for inflation) to be awarded annually to Waterford public high school graduates. These scholarships will recognize students who possess social talents and gifts, an eagerness to learn and succeed, and have the potential to make substantial social contributions in their lifetime.

### **Eligibility Requirements and Criteria for Selection:**

An applicant must be a Waterford public high school graduating senior in good standing. Priority will be given to students who are not likely to receive a scholarship based on the usual criteria of athletics, scholastic excellence, or the like. The scholarship will be awarded to deserving students in the minds of the scholarship committee because of:

- Social skills
- Eagerness to participate in society and/or learn
- Probability that the particular student will make a substantial contribution to society over their life, particularly if an educational opportunity is afforded them
- Potential to complete a full college/trade/technical program if given financial assistance.

**Deadline is First Friday in March**

# Application Package Requirements

## 1. A Completed Application Form.

## 2. Three Letters of Recommendation.

One each from the following individuals, who must be non-relatives:

- Teacher, counselor, or school administrator
- Community member, coach, youth or club advisor, volunteer coordinator or employer
- Peer or friend

Letters should highlight the applicant's participation in the community and school. Please comment on community service, volunteer work and/or employment experience, school, and community contributions, activities or efforts to help others. Describe the applicant's social skills, motivation to serve and succeed, and potential for leadership. Include specific examples.

## 3. Personal Essay

Please describe for the selection committee your goals, aspirations, and anticipated major. Include what you hope to contribute to society. Autobiographical information will be helpful. Describe your best assets. If you have encountered obstacles, describe how you overcame them.

*Limit your typed response to a 12 point, double spaced, one side, 8 1/2 x 11 paper.*

## 4. Academic Record

Enclose a copy of your transcript.

## 5. Final Selection

Interviews will be held with the finalists. The decisions of the selection committee is final.
