#### RECOGNITION OF ACHIEVEMENT

2023 marked the Golden Jubilee year for the Waterford Senior Center and Waterford School District. Tonight, we continue to celebrate more than 50 years of dedicated service the Waterford Senior Center has provided to our community. Waterford's seniors enjoy a wide variety of offerings from the Senior Center, including recreational activities and human service programs, including the Meals-on-Wheels program, providing hot, nutritious and delicious meals to Waterford's homebound seniors.

Beginning in January, the Waterford Senior Center will merge with the Waterford Parks and Recreation Department. These amazing teams will join forces to continue providing essential senior programs, events and services for Waterford Township.

As we transition, the Board of Education extends our sincere gratitude and admiration for the work you do and the difference you make in our community. We thank every staff member, volunteer, community partner and contributor who supports the efforts of the Waterford Senior Center. We are pleased to further recognize Erin Asdell, Senior Center Coordinator, and Donielle Fidler, Auxiliary Services Director, for ensuring Waterford's seniors are inspired, educated, and empowered to thrive!

Seeing no objection, the consent agenda was approved as presented.

#### **INFORMATION ITEMS**

#### a. District Controls

The 2020 Bond, approved by voters on August 4, 2020, included replacing the district's HVAC (Heating, Ventilation, and Air Conditioning) controls. The controls for HVAC equipment transmit information from the equipment to the management system so that the equipment can be monitored and controlled remotely.

The bid includes replacing the JACE (Java Application Control Engine) panels at the following schools/buildings: Cooley, Grayson, Haviland, Houghton, Knudsen, Riverside, and Schoolcraft Elementary Schools, Central Warehouse, Covert Center, Crary Campus, Lutes, and Kingsley Montgomery School. The other district buildings have had their controls replaced in recent years.

In addition, the controls for the fume hoods at the high school science classrooms are being replaced. The fume hoods exhaust unwanted gases, fumes, and vapors in an enclosed space so students can conduct experiments in a safe environment. Originally installed as part of the 2000 addition, the recent upgrades in the HVAC equipment at the high schools involved a transition from pneumatic to electrical controls, requiring an update in the controls for the fume hoods.

A recommendation for the bid will be presented at the next regular Board meeting.

#### b. Pierce Remodel and Field Replacement

The 2020 Bond, approved by voters on August 4, 2020, included remodeling the middle school gymnasiums and the Waterford Pierce Middle School football field. Several items were identified for replacement or upgrades with the architects, the principal, and the athletic director.

In the auxiliary gym, the floor will be replaced, the space painted, new basketball backboards will be added, and windows will be added for natural light. In the competition gym, the floor will be refinished or replaced (depending on bids); the backboards will be moved to allow for two half courts and the bleachers will be replaced.

In the main entrance corridor, the ceiling will be replaced and new lighting added.

A new synthetic turf field will be installed, with new goalposts and a scoreboard. The track will be replaced, and the lanes expanded from 36" to 42". The fence line will be replaced, and new concrete walks for access to the visitors' bleachers will be added.

A recommendation for the bid award will be presented at the next regular Board meeting.

#### c. Mason Remodel

The 2020 Bond, approved by voters on August 4, 2020, included remodeling the middle school gymnasiums. Several items were identified for replacement or upgrades with the architects, the principal, and the athletic director.

In the main gym, the floor will be refinished or replaced (depending on bids), restriped to adjust the main court length, flooring added to the mezzanine area, the home bleachers replaced, and the lighting replaced.

In the building, the media center and the teachers' lounge will get new flooring/carpet, and a corridor section will be captured for a student space.

A recommendation for the bid award will be presented at the next regular Board meeting.

d. Food Service Contract – Waterford Township Senior Center

As of January 1, 2025, the Senior Center located at the Leggett building will be overseen by the Waterford Township. The District has provided food service for the Senior Center's congregate meals and their Meals on Wheels programs for many years.

No contract was needed for the service provided when the Senior Center was part of the District. The Township has requested a contract to formalize the expectations for the service.

The District will provide staff and food, and the Township's Senior Center will provide a kitchen and equipment to prepare the food. The District's Food Service Department will be reimbursed on a per-meal basis from grants and donations received by the Senior Center for those purposes. The reimbursement rate in the contract intends to covers the costs incurred by the District.

The contract dates are January 1, 2025, to September 30, 2026. The ending date corresponds with the grant date for the Senior Center's nutrition programs.

The attached contract has been reviewed by the District's and Township's attorneys and the departments. At the next regular meeting, the Board will be asked to approve the contract and have the Assistant Superintendent of Business & Operations sign on behalf of the Board.

e. Tentative Agreement: WASA

Susan File, Executive Director of Human Resources, provided an update on the proposed tentative agreement with the Waterford Association of School Administrators (WASA). A recommendation to approve the tentative agreement is presented under New Business.

  - 1. Recommendation 36-24-25 Relative to Purchase Agreement: Hermana Property

Moved by Member Torres and supported by Member Josselyn that the Board of Education approve the purchase agreement to sell the District's "Hermana Road" vacant property to PH Homes Inc., in the amount of \$675,000. It was further recommended that the Board approve the Interim Superintendent to sign the agreement.

The Hermana Road property, located by Lochaven Road and Greer Road, is approximately 12 acres of vacant property listed on the District's Surplus Property list for sale.

PH Homes Inc, is a home developer, whose intent is to purchase the property to build homes.

The purchase agreement details timelines for certain work to be done; if the timelines are not met the District can cancel the agreement. If the timelines are met, the District will sell the property to the buyer for the agreed price.

TOPIC: T5 PA Systems

The 2020 Bond, approved by voters on August 4, 2020, included replacement of our PA (Public Address) systems across the district through technology and safety upgrades. In May 2024 a committee of stakeholders was formed to review our current systems, determine what features should be included in bid specifications and prioritize replacement schedules.

The bid includes replacing the PA systems with IP (Internet Protocol) based PA Systems, which allow for day-to-day announcements as well as programmed targeted communications, digital clocks, strobe lights, and emergency alerts at the following schools/buildings: Donelson Hills, Riverside, and Knudsen Elementary Schools, Pierce Middle School, Kettering High School, Mott High School, Kingsley Montgomery School, and Crary Campus.

In addition, Beaumont, Cooley, Grayson, Haviland, Houghton, Schoolcraft Elementary Schools, and Mason Middle School have been included as alternates within the bid. These buildings' systems are not quite out of date, but they will need to be upgraded to an IP-based system to align with the same functionality as those buildings within the bid for safety and security measures.

A recommendation for the bid will be presented at the next regular Board meeting.

TOPIC: Elementary Playground Improvements – Phase 2

As part of the 2020 Bond, approved by voters on August 4, 2020, upgrades to the elementary playgrounds were included. The District worked with a certified playground designer and the building principals to design plans for each school.

The review of the current playgrounds looked at the existing equipment, layout, and options for new equipment and designs. Pricing for new equipment is being requested through cooperative bid sites, while Barton Malow issued a bid for the installation and site work. Proposals were due January 10, 2025.

The playground improvements were split over two summers to fit within other district construction projects being done at the same time. For summer 2024, Beaumont, Donelson Hills, Grayson, and Houghton Elementary Schools had their playgrounds updated. For summer 2025, Cooley, Haviland, Knudsen, Riverside, and Schoolcraft Elementary Schools will have their playgrounds updated. In addition, some additional old equipment will be replaced at the three elementary playgrounds completed last year.

A recommendation for new equipment purchase and the site work award will be presented at the February 20, 2025, regular Board meeting.
